- Recess Patrol. Officers continued the Department's program of meeting with children during recess breaks at Bayside and Willow Creek Academy.


### TRAFFIC MONITORING

#### **MONTHLY CASE SUMMARY**

- While investigating the theft of a generator, William McClean and Lauren Thacher of Sausalito were identified as the suspects. The generator was recovered and charges were filed against the suspects.
- Officers responded to three additional theft reports along the waterfront. Items were either taken from vessels or off the docks.
- There were four reports of vehicle burglaries this month. Side windows were smashed out in order to steal items of value that were left in plain view.
- Officers responded to two commercial burglary reports. In one of the cases, Joseph Andrade of Sausalito was arrested for stealing property from Bridgeway Gas.
- Three bicycle thefts were reported to officers. One bicycle was recovered and returned to the owner and the suspect was identified. The investigation is on-going
- There were four other miscellaneous thefts in town this month. All of the thefts were items that were left unsecured and unattended.
- While on patrol, officers on-viewed a female being assaulted by a male. The victim's boyfriend, Erik Lopez of Novato, was arrested for domestic violence.

# **DETECTIVE UPDATE**

- Detective Mather looked into the recent auto burglaries in the south end of town. The investigations are ongoing.
- Detective Mather, following up on an anonymous tip, searched a storage container on Marinship Way. Detective Mather seized 167 pounds on marijuana. Nicholas Pappas of Sausalito was charged with various drug violations.
