What is Enki?

Enki is a library of thousands of free electronic books in the EPUB format. The collection was developed by Califa, a not-for-profit membership cooperative serving libraries in California. Enki is the first library controlled and maintained e-book platform in California.

What is available and what can I check out?

- Content is currently focused on smaller and independent publishers including McGraw-Hill, Workman, Akashic, Independent Publishers Group (IPG), and Smashwords.
- You may check out 5 books at a time for 14 days each.
- Books may be returned early.
- Up to 5 holds may be placed on titles that are currently checked out by someone else.

How do I use Enki?

You will need your Sausalito library card and PIN and you must be a Marin County resident.

Books are in the EPUB format. Devices that support EPUB include iPads, iPhones, Kindle Fire (but not e-ink kindles), Android tablets and phones, Nooks, and desktop and laptop computers of all kinds.

You will need to download a reading app like Bluefire or Overdrive to your device. Go to your device's app to search for, download, and install one of these apps.

You will need a free Adobe ID. To set an Adobe ID, Google "Adobe ID" in your web browser and click on the first link, then click "Don't have an Adobe ID?"

To search or browse the collection, point the browser on your device to marin.enkilibrary.org

When you find a title that you want to read, select "Checkout." Then select "Download" and choose a reading app like Overdrive or Bluefire to use to open the book. If you are using a laptop or desktop computer, you can use the "Read Online" feature.
