Portable Signs

Zoning Ordinance Section 10.42.050.G

Sausalito's Sign Regulations prohibit the installation of all Portable Signs (except valet parking signs and restaurant menu boards). Portable Signs, including but not limited to, A-frame signs, T-frame signs and sandwich boards, located along sidewalks reduce the walkable width available for pedestrians and wheelchair users; create obstacles and trip hazards; and damage landscaping.

- Any Portable Signs located on private property are subject to Code Enforcement action and may result in the issuance of a citation that would involve monetary fines.
- Any portable signs located in the public right-of-way will be removed by the Sausalito Department of Public Works. (Removed signs will be held for fourteen days at the City Corporation Yard at 530 Nevada Street. Signs not claimed within fourteen days of removal by the Department of Public Works will be disposed.)
