The City of Sausalito will be hosting a Disaster Preparedness Awareness Day for the public on Saturday, October 15, 2011 from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM. This event is being held in conjunction with the City of Sausalito's Annual Yard Sale.

The Disaster Preparedness Awareness Day event is being conducted by the City of Sausalito's Disaster Preparedness Committee along with the Sausalito Police Department, Southern Marin Fire Protection District, and several other organizations such as the Sausalito Volunteers in Public Safety (VIPS), the Southern Marin Citizen Emergency Response Team (CERT), and Radio Sausalito 1610 AM.

The goal of the Disaster Preparedness Awareness Day is to educate the public regarding the importance of and methods for preparing themselves, their families, and their communities to best handle disasters and emergencies that they may encounter. The public will also have the opportunity to learn what steps the City of Sausalito is taking in the realm of disaster preparedness and emergency management.
