PROJECT DESCRIPTION The Sausalito Department of Public Works and the Sausalito Chamber of Commerce are seeking Historic Landmarks Board input for a Design Review Permit and a Sign Permit for the installation of Wayfinding Guide signs at the following locations:

- Bridgeway/Princess Street
- Ferry Landing
- Bridgeway/Bay St.
- Bridgeway/Ensign St./San Carlos Ave./Caledonia St.
- Bridgeway/Johnson Street
- Bridgeway/Napa Street

Two of the proposed wayfinding signs are located in within the Downtown Historic Overlay Zoning District and therefore subject to Historic Landmarks Board consideration of sign design. The project was previously heard by the Planning Commission and the Historic Landmarks Board on February 26, 2014, and the public hearing was continued for additional information.
