- Officers performed bar checks to ensure clients and employees were acting in accordance with ABC laws.


## TRAFFIC MONITORING

#### MONTHLY CASE SUMMARY

- A 52 year old San Francisco man was arrested for stealing a \$2,000 bicycle.
- Officers responded to the report of a subject trying to enter a bank in town while brandishing a firearm. The suspect could not gain entry and fled the area prior to officers arrival.
- A 30 year old N. Carolina man and a 24 year old Texas man were arrested for burglary after they stole several items from a local business.
- After officers arrested a 53 year old homeless man for public intoxication, they located a stolen credit card on his person. The man later admitted that he used the stolen card to purchase alcohol. Additional criminal charges of burglary and possession of stolen property were added.
- Officers responded to the report of a sexual assault that occurred in a downtown area park.
- An employee of a local business reported that he was robbed at gunpoint by an unknown male. The employee was restrained with zip ties and left on the floor of the business.

## **DETECTIVE UPDATE**

- Detective Mather conducted follow-up investigations on a child pornography case and a sexual assault that occurred in Gabrielson Park.
- Detective McMahon followed up on a forgery case in which the suspect charged over \$50,000 in the victim's name.
